



## Tournament rules



- 4 games, 40 minutes length each (2x20 min. running time, 3 min. half time)
- All games are 7v7 (other than U-11 which is 9v9)
- maximum roster is not set but awards are based on 12 players (15 at U-11)
- all players must be in the proper age group (or playing up) playing older players will result in the disqualification of the team from the tournament
- all parents must sign a waiver provided to the coaches prior to the first game
- subs are on the fly to minimize game interruptions...subs must be made from the half way line and players MUST be off the field before the new player is entering
- teams might be asked to play back to back games if needed (once only)
- if a game ended prematurely due to lightning or heavy rain the score will stand
- Referee decisions are final...they are human and can make mistakes...please control your parents and refrain from addressing the refs.
- Offside rules apply...see above comments about refs.
- In case of a tie here are the tie breakers:
  1. Head to head
  2. Wins
  3. Goal differential (max. 3 per win)
  4. goals against
  5. shutouts
- Overtime in playoff games is 10 min. running time with a “Golden Goal rule” (game is over when a goal is scored) followed by a shootout if needed (5 kicks each)
- Home team is listed first and will need to change their jerseys in case of a conflict
